Sub: Scheme of evaluation of Mathematics at All India Secondary School Examinations (AISS Class X) March 2020 onwards. (Ref: CBSE Circular No : Acad 03/2019 dated 10/1/2019)

In response to the subject referred, we are pleased to inform you that the directorate of Academics, CBSE Delhi has decided to introduce two different levels of examination in Mathematics (Subject Code 041) for the students appearing for the final Board Examination during the academic session ending March 2020 onwards. (AISS March 2020) Kindly note following guidelines in this regard

Objective & Scope

It has been observed by CBSE that students of Class X generally experience difficulty in comprehending the subject Mathematics leading to stress, both before and during the course of studies/ exams thereby causing a decline in their performance and academic score in Mathematics. Keeping in view of this important aspect as evidenced by the Board results over a period of time, CBSE has decided to have two different levels of examination named as **Mathematics – STANDARD** for the existing level of examination and **Mathematics – BASIC** for an easier level of examination commencing from March 2020 onwards.

Salient features of the Scheme:

1. The syllabus, class room teaching and internal assessment for both levels of examinations would remain the same so that students get the chance to learn the whole range of topics throughout the academic year as prescribed by CBSE
2. The STANDARD level is meant for those students who wish to opt for Mathematics at Senior Secondary level (XI & XII) and the BASIC LEVEL is for those who are not so keen to pursue Mathematics at higher levels of study
3. Every student has the right to choose his/her option between the two levels of examination STANDARD or BASIC and the school will make necessary arrangements to register his / her option with CBSE shortly.
4. In case if a student fails at either level of Mathematics, he / she can appear at the compartment examination as per norms of CBSE according to the options given below.

| In case of failure in | Compartment options |
|-----------------------|-------------------------------|
| Math – Basic | Math Basic |
| Math - Standard | Math – Standard or Math Basic |

5. In case if a student who qualified in Math – Basic intends to pursue Mathematics at Senior Secondary Level (XI & XII), CBSE permits him / her to appear for an improvement examination in Mathematics – STANDARD on request at the time of compartment examinations as per norms
6. CBSE shall provide details of design of Question papers for both levels in due course of time.

Parents and students are hereby requested to avail this new learner friendly approach and facility extended to them with an objective to learn Mathematics in a stress free environment aiming at greater levels of academic excellence. Indeed this will be a blessing for all students intending to choose their higher studies in science, Commerce or Humanities without Mathematics as one of their optional subjects.

In case of any clarification feel free to contact concerned subject teachers/ Class teachers before 21st April 2019. School reserves the right to advice for a decision based on child's performance in Maths in first evaluation.
