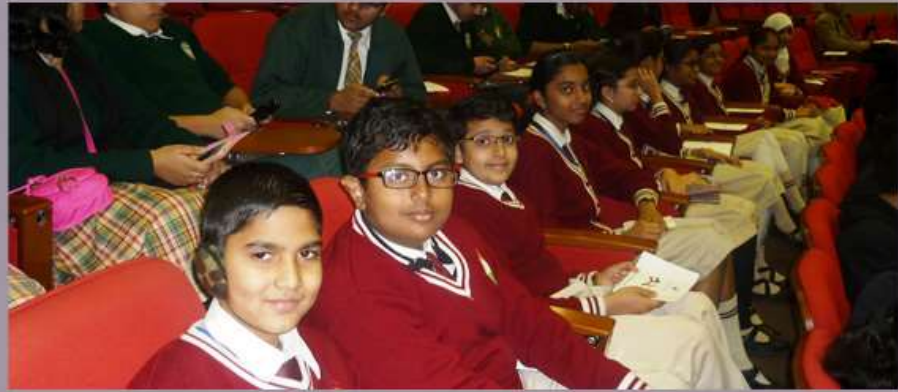
ICSK KHAITAN STUDENTS' VISIT NATIONAL LIBRARY OF KUWAIT

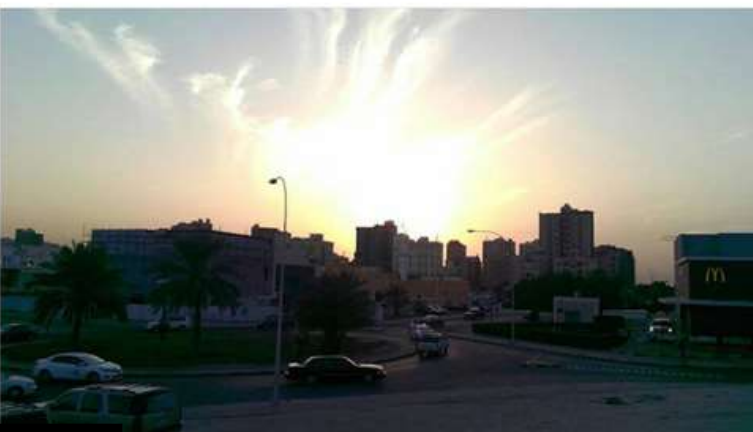
The most eye catching item of the day was the last one where each child in the cap and gown marched elegantly on the stage to receive their diplomas.

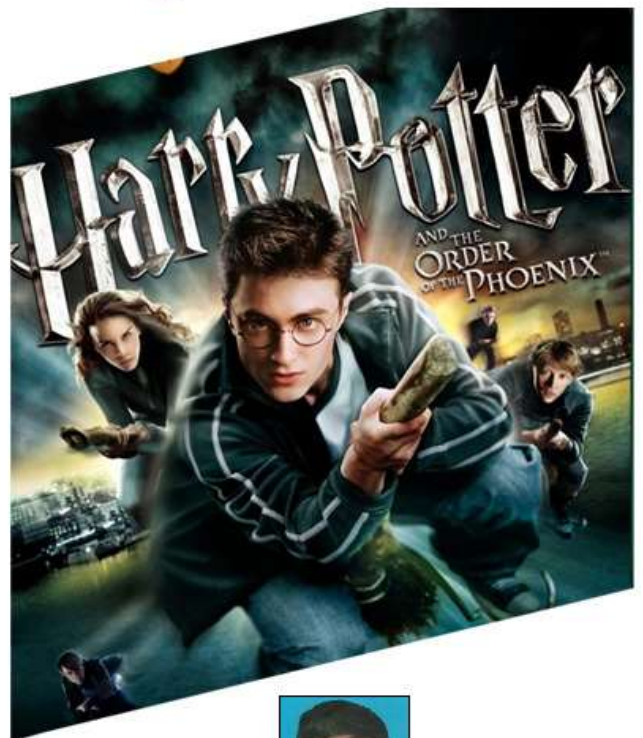
